6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 7 of Chapter 13 of Title 56 a section numbered
7	56-425.1 relating to railroad safety; minimum train crew; movement of freight; civil penalties.
8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 7 of Chapter 13 of Title 56 a section
10	numbered 56-425.1 as follows:
11	§ 56-425.1. Minimum train crew; movement of freight; civil penalties.
12	No railroad company shall use or allow the use of any train, locomotive, or light engine in
13	connection with the movement of freight unless it has a crew consisting of at least two qualified
14	individuals. The provisions of this section shall not apply to the use of a train, locomotive, or light engine
15	for hostler or utility service. Any railroad company violating the provisions of this section shall be fined
16	not less than \$500 nor more than \$2,000. For a second violation within three years, such railroad company
17	shall be fined not less than \$1,000 nor more than \$5,000. For a third or subsequent violation within three
18	years of the first violation, such railroad company shall be fined not less than \$5,000 nor more than
19	\$10,000. The number of violations within three years shall be measured by the dates that the violations
20	occur.
