6	A BILL to amend the Code of Virginia by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 8 of Title 23.1 a section numbered
7	23.1-808.2, relating to institutions of higher education; campus safety and emergency preparedness
8	training; first-year completion and biennial review.
9	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
10	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding in Article 2 of Chapter 8 of Title 23.1 a section
11	numbered 23.1-808.2 as follows:
12	§ 23.1-808.2. Campus safety and emergency preparedness training; first-year completion
13	and biennial review.
14	A. The governing board of each public institution of higher education shall develop and implement
15	policies requiring that a campus safety and emergency preparedness training program be provided to and
16	completed by all first-year students by the last day of each student's first academic term and reviewed
17	biennially by each returning student at such institution. Such training program shall focus on active shooter
18	event preparedness and may be offered in any format, including a virtual format, and may include any
19	supplementary materials that the governing board of each public institution of higher education deems
20	appropriate.
21	B. The Council shall encourage private institutions of higher education to develop and implement
22	policies requiring a campus safety and emergency preparedness training program be provided to and
23	completed by all first-year students by the last day of each student's first academic term and reviewed
24	biennially by each returning student enrolled at such institutions.
