8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. That the Department of Human Resource Management shall convene a work group to identify and
10	analyze options for allowing collective bargaining by public employees in the Commonwealth. The work
11	group shall consist of representatives from the Department of Labor and Industry and staff of the House
12	Committee on Appropriations and the Senate Committee on Finance and Appropriations and may include
13	any other relevant stakeholders.
14	The work group shall consider (i) options for a public employee relations board that could be
15	authorized to determine appropriate bargaining units and provide for the certification and decertification
16	of elections for exclusive bargaining representatives of state employees and local government employees;
17	(ii) requirements related to public employers and employee organizations that are exclusive bargaining
18	representatives meeting at reasonable times to negotiate in good faith with respect to wages, hours, and
19	other terms and conditions of employment; and (iii) any necessary changes to the Code of Virginia to
20	effectuate and implement any options considered by the work group. The work group shall report its
21	findings to the General Assembly by November 1, 2024.
