8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. That the Code of Virginia is amended by adding a section numbered 22.1-7.1:1 as follows:
10	§ 22.1-7.1:1. Board; guidance on best practices for open school enrollment policies.
11	The Board shall develop and make available to each school board guidance on best practices
12	relating to open school enrollment policies as permitted pursuant to § 22.1-7.1. Such guidance shall detail
13	best practices relating to:
14	1. The student application process, including an exemplar application;
15	2. The maintenance of a waitlist and for the random selection of applicants in the event that student
16	applications exceed a given school's enrollment capacity or available seats by grade level;
17	3. Processes for reporting and making publicly available the open enrollment capacity of each
18	school or program;
19	4. The prohibition against charging tuition or fees, in accordance with the provisions of § 22.1-5
20	and subdivision G 1 of 8VAC20-720-80, to any student who enrolls pursuant to an open enrollment policy;
21	5. Student transportation;
22	6. Processes for reviewing disciplinary actions that may disqualify students from utilizing the open
23	school enrollment policy; and
24	7. The continued enrollment of students pursuant to an open school enrollment policy.
