8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. The Department of Education (the Department), in consultation with such stakeholders and experts
10	as it deems necessary or appropriate, shall develop (i) age-appropriate and evidence-based education
11	materials concerning the risks to health and safety that are posed by opioids, with a particular focus on
12	prevention, identification of the signs of overdose, resources for supports, risks, and effects of addiction,
13	and the risk of death that is posed by fentanyl and (ii) guidelines for school boards for incorporating the
14	education materials developed pursuant to clause (i) into instructional programs for students enrolled in
15	the local school division. The Department shall submit to the Chairs of the House Committee on Education
16	and the Senate Committee on Education and Health by November 1, 2024, the education materials and
17	guidelines developed in accordance with the provisions of this act.
