6	A BILL to require the Superintendent of Public Instruction to convene a stakeholder work group to study

8	Be it enacted by the General Assembly of Virginia:
9	1. § 1. The Superintendent of Public Instruction, in coordination with the Secretary of Education, shall
10	convene a stakeholder work group to (i) study the estimated impact of offering free school meals to
11	students statewide, (ii) identify options to reduce or eliminate student and school meal debt, and (iii) make
12	recommendations regarding options to leverage other programs funded at the state and federal levels for
13	student school meals. The work group shall be chaired by the Superintendent of Public Instruction and
14	shall include relevant stakeholders, including representatives of local school divisions and individuals
15	with expertise in providing innovative solutions at the state and local levels to provide free school meals
16	to students. The work group shall report its findings and recommendations to the Joint Subcommittee on
17	Elementary and Secondary Education Funding by November 1, 2024.
